268 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Chairman read out the following statement. Members are referred to, and shall observe, the provisions of the Hemsworth Town Council's Code of Conduct. If a Councillor has a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest he/she must, unless a dispensation has been granted, withdraw from the meeting room and take no part in the discussion or vote. If any interest (Pecuniary or Non-Pecuniary) has not been entered in the Town Council's register then you must disclose it at the meeting and inform the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of the date of initial disclosure. Failure to abide by the provisions of the Code in regard to Disclosable Pecuniary Interests now amounts to a criminal offence.

No disclosures were made.

269 CITY ESTATE RE-DEVELOPMENT (REFER TO MIN NO'S 68D, 126B & 183B)

The Town Clerk provided contractual and legal information relating to the proposed development and details of the work undertaken by the Consultant.

The Chairman gave further details explaining the need to secure the conditions highlighted by the Town Clerk (recommendations by the Consultant) - 5 points to be addressed by WMDC before approval was given to remove the objection.

Members discussed this matter raising issues on the details put forward and Councillor Draper proposed that this Town Council ensures that the 5 points are agreed to before the objection is removed. This was seconded by Councillor Wilson.
